Describe this incredible place, as if you were writing it for the Magic Carpet Airlines, and give several reasons explaining why you would take Jasmine there.

2. Aladdin handed the lamp to Genie and advised him to bury it "a thousand miles underground." Do you think Genie did what Aladdin asked? Did Genie toss it in the ocean?
